Josh Ruebner, a Jewish voice and a son of an Israeli, is the National Advocacy Director for the coalition called "US Campaign to End the Israeli Occupation," which is made up of more than 320 groups and organizations in the country. The US Campaign's strategy is to inform, educate, and mobilize the public so as to change the U.S. role in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict to support peace, justice, human rights, and international law.

Josh will come to speak at Temple, educating the listeners on the economic complications of billions of US tax dollars being delivered to Israel in expense of other, particularly domestic, state of affairs; as well as the illegal and inhumane activities of both the US and Israel in their direct and indirect actions toward Palestine and the Palestinian people. Josh Ruebner co-founded Jews for Peace in Palestine and Israel (JPPI), which later merged with Jewish Voice for Peace. Before becoming an activist, Mr. Ruebner used to work as a Middle East Analyst with Congressional Research Service (CRS), a non-partisan federal government agency which conducts research for Members of Congress. He has appeared on television stations such as NBC, MSNBC, and al-Jazeera; has been interviewed on dozens of radio and television programs; and his writings have appeared in such publications as the *Detroit Free Press*, *Cleveland Plain Dealer*
